# Hermandad Provides 7 Scholarships to C3Tec Students

Last month, Hermandad helped seven young students participate in a Coding Maker Club Program. Their ages span from 10-years-old to their upper teens. Each student wrote a compelling essay identifying their desire to attend and offered their learning goals, application of learning the technology and how this experience could be used for their future educational and professional ambitions and plans. A majority of these students attend public school in Puerto Rico and do not have access to learning coding, video games, and robotics. This program will promote team work and sharing of ideas.

The students will assemble and program a robot, create and program a video game, and compete with their robots and video games. Jean and John plan to meet with the students during a future visit and learn about their robots, games, and overall experience from the program.

David Garcia performed works by Domienico Scarlatti, Robert Schumann, Frederic Chopin and Claude Debussy. After our a short intermission, vocalist Kathleen Hackett, now a third year student at Peabody Conservatory presented a program that included pieces by Ned Rorem, Claude Debussy, Joseph Marx, Rosephayne Powell, Benjamin Britten, Leonard Bernstein, Albert Roussel, César Frank, G.F. Handel, Alfredo Casella, and John Duke.

Kathleen's accompanist, Dr. Xin Wu, is a pianist specializing in opera, vocal coaching, and collaborative performance. She serves as an accompanist and vocal coach at Morgan State University and a staff pianist at the Peabody Conservatory and Preparatory, where she works closely with singers to prepare for recitals, competitions, and professional engagements.
